

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT ***PARKING***

As a commuting student, you have many discount parking options when you drive to Moore College of Art & Design.

LAZ - Edgewater Garage at 23rd and Race Streets.

The Edgewater Garage is currently transitioning from a paper voucher system to an online payment system.

Currently, you can still purchase parking passes from the deck attendant. These paper passes must be purchased in sets of 10 at \$7 per pass. Please see the office in the deck to purchase passes.

Online Payment Information:

The Garage is still transitioning to the new online payment system, please use paper passes until they're no longer available. After paper passes have ended, use the online payment system at <http://moore.edu/admissions/student-life/transportation-parking>

The rate for this garage will be **\$6.75 for 10 hours** for students who pre-pay online. You will need to pay for your parking online via the Moore Transportation page. **After 10 hours, the rate will increase to \$13.75.**

If you are using pre-paid online (best deal, \$6.75 per day for MOORE students):

When you enter the garage, you will take an entry ticket.

When you leave the garage in your car, you will insert your entry ticket and then scan your phone for your online payment. The gate will open, and you can drive out.

If you are not using the online purchase (regular parking rate, \$11.00 per day)

You can use CREDIT CARD IN AND OUT... No ticket needed. When you enter the garage, just insert a valid credit card into the reader at the entry station. The gate will open. When you leave the garage, insert the same credit card into the reader at the exit station. The station will calculate your parking fee, automatically charge your credit card and issue you a receipt.

- OR -

Just take a ticket... When you enter the garage, take a ticket and park your car. When you return to the garage, pay at the ground level pay station (located at the Race Street Exit) BEFORE you go to your car. Your ticket will be encoded with a 20 minute grace period for you to exit the garage. As you drive out, just insert your paid ticket into the exit machine – the gate will open.

- OR -

You can insert your unpaid ticket in the exit reader and pay with your credit card on the way out.

Driving directions to Edgewater Garage:

Take Cherry Street or Arch Street to 22nd Street.

Make a right on 22nd Street.

Make a left onto Summer Street (Summer Street is a small street just before you get to the Schuylkill Expressway overpass).

At the end of Summer Street, make a left. Be careful at this intersection, as you will merge with traffic coming off of the expressway.

Make the 1st right onto Race Street.

Make a right into Edgewater Garage.

The Franklin Institute - Expert Parking

Students may purchase monthly passes directly from the Garage Manager, between the hours of 7:00 AM - 3:00 PM, Monday through Friday only. Her phone number is 215-448-1391. Her office is located inside the parking garage at the exit, level P2, on the right side as you are leaving. When you arrive at the garage to park, you would enter the parking garage at the 21st Street entrance and take a daily ticket.

Please note there are a limited number of permit spaces. Currently, there is a waitlist for a monthly spot

You must purchase monthly passes, offered for the discounted rate of \$150. The garage office will accept cash, MasterCard, or Visa. *Parking passes are non-transferable, which means they cannot be used by anyone else but the person that purchased them.

To exit after hours, press red buzzer (located on right hand side of garage right before exiting) or telephone 215-448-0908 to contact the on-site attendant.

Kennedy House Garage located at 1901 JFK Boulevard - night and weekend parking.

This garage will be available to you from 4pm-12am Monday through Friday and all day on weekends for only \$7.00 per day. You must pick up these tickets in the Student Services office ten at a time, between 9am-5pm Monday through Friday, and you can redeem them for your discount as you exit the garage.

Parkway Corporation - 1919 Arch Street

Daytime Parking (Monday-Friday before 5PM) - \$8.00

Evening/Weekend Parking (Monday-Friday after 5PM, anytime on Saturday-Sunday) - \$6.00

Monthly Parking (7 days a week) - \$150.00
